1. Place the Shield

Position externally against the perineal area for a secure, comfortable fit.

2. Connect & Start

Attach tubing and backflow valve, then connect to suction.

3. Collect

Urine flows directly into a collection bag or canister for safe disposal.

4. Replace

Change shield or collection bag as needed (usually daily or when soiled).



DAILY CARE TIPS

Skin Care

Clean the perineal area daily with mild soap and warm water. Pat dry gently.

Check Tubing

Look for kinks or bends so urine flows freely.

Hydration **&**Nutrition

Offer fluids often, unless the provider says otherwise.

Positioning

Place the shield securely but comfortably, making sure it doesn't press on skin.

Monitor Output

Write down urine amounts if the care team asks.

Comfort

Reposition the patient regularly to protect skin and improve comfort.



SAFETY & INFECTION CONTROL



Hand Hygiene

Always wash or sanitize hands before and after touching the shield, tubing, or bag.

Gloves

Wear disposable gloves when changing or cleaning parts.

Shield Care

Replace the shield if it looks soiled, damaged, or uncomfortable.

Tubing & Bag

Check for leaks or blockages. Empty the collection bag before it gets too full.

Cleaning

Use only approved cleaning wipes or soap and water on reusable parts. Do not use harsh chemicals.

Observation

Watch for redness, swelling, fever, or foul-smelling urine. Report these signs to the care team.





REPLACING COMPONENTS

Shield

 Replace daily or sooner if soiled, damaged, or uncomfortable.

Valve

- Inspect for leaks.
- Replace every 2-4 weeks or as directed.

Tubing

- Check daily for kinks or residue.
- Replace weekly, or sooner if clogged or contaminated.

Suction Unit / Canister

- Empty when 2/3 full.
- Replace disposable liners or canisters as needed.



FAQs

How often should I change the GentleDrain™ Shield?

Replace daily, or sooner if it becomes soiled, damaged, or uncomfortable.

Is it safe for patients with sensitive skin?

Yes. The shield is made with soft, medical-grade materials. If irritation occurs, stop use and consult a healthcare provider.

What if urine stops flowing?

Check for kinks in the tubing, confirm suction is connected, and replace parts if needed.

Can GentleDrain™ be used overnight?

Yes. GentleDrain™ is designed for continuous use, including overnight, with proper placement and monitoring. It is suitable for both bedbound and limited-mobility patients. Position securely for comfort and drainage.

Do caregivers need special training?

No special certification is needed. Most caregivers can use GentleDrainTM after a short demonstration or by following our guide.
